Covid 19 – Each individual entering has the primary responsibility for his or her own health and wellbeing and any risk factors relating to age or health, or health of close contacts, should be considered before entering an event. Government guidelines on social distancing, in force at the time, must be adhered to, whilst at the trial. There will be no handling of entry forms, cheques, or cash on the day, **all payments in advance.**

Our Covid Safety Officer will be Mike Jones or Elvin Thomas who may deputize this role on the day. Confirmation will be given on arrival.

Entries: Retriever trials -FTMS preferred. Spaniel trials - Paper entries Preference is that you type your entry, print and post to the Spaniel Sec. Please send your entry in early to allow for quarantining before the draw. **Draws** will be published on the club website and returned via SAE if provided. **Field trial Cards** will be issued electronically in advance to all competitors if covid rules dictate, otherwise will be available on the day. **Any individual not following Government Guidelines, or who is deemed to be putting the safety of others at risk will be asked to leave the trial ground.**

- Competitors should be aware that all communication, including the draw and Field Trial card, will be undertaken electronically if necessary. – The draw will be put on the club website and returned via SAE (or FTMS for retrievers).
- Competitors **MUST** provide their own face mask and hand sanitiser to use at appropriate times.
- Competitors **will be** required to provide their own number for identification purposes when in line. This does not need to be an armband but must be clearly visible to the judge when the handler joins the line.
- Spectators are not allowed, (other than a nominated person to hold a 2nd dog if applicable)

- Competitors must be aware that if they, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must not attend the event and should self-isolate in line with Government advice.
- Competitors must not attend a Field Trial if they reside in an area covered by a local down enforced by the Government.
- Competitors may be required to carry their own game during the day, please bring a suitable game bag/vest.

Start Time – All Trials meet at **9.00am** hrs for a **9.30am** prompt start – where reserves will be put in.

All Trials – Will be held in accordance with the current Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Club. Reserves will be approached in a strict order. If a reserve cannot be contacted despite all possible efforts, the next reserve will be offered the run. This decision will stand even if the original reserve appears at the trial. Entry Fees may only be retained under Rule J7.F (1)- (5). Should any stake be abandoned, after all expenses are paid the remaining monies will be divided between the nominees. Those applicants that do not get a run will have their cheques destroyed. The Club reserves the right to refuse entries. Persons who have been refused membership may not enter this society's Trials. Should circumstances so dictate the society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements, as necessary. **Late Entry** – If your entry arrives after the closing date it may be put at the end of the draw. No substitution of dogs while reserves stand for Retriever or Spaniel trials. **Withdrawals** – Reg J7f applies. After an applicant has been successful in a draw, or reserve accepted an offer of a run the applicant may be liable for the full entry fee if the place is not taken up by another competitor, unless a veterinary certificate is produced, Open stake winners where qualification to the championship has been gained, or Novice dogs have qualified out of novice or gained an open stake award after the draw, or in the case of local lock down or Covid isolation. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. All dog's resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the competitor. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements, as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host. **Open-** A Stake in which dogs have the opportunity of gaining a qualification towards the title of Field Trial Champion (K Regulations refer) and towards entry in the Championship or Champion Stake for its breed; in which entry is open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds except that such Stakes may not be confined to Any Variety Spaniel [except Spaniel (Cocker) and Spaniel (English Springer)]. It may be limited to a prescribed number of runners (J4 refers), in which case these shall be decided by a draw conducted in accordance with Regulation J7.i. so that preference is given to previous performance. **Novice** Retrievers/Spaniels: A Stake which is confined to dogs which have not gained a place which would qualify them for first preference in the draw for Open Stakes. **Prizes** – Certificates & Appropriate trophies. Prize money for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings. **Trophies** must be returned 1 month before the trial – Failure to return a Trophy by this date will result in a fine of £50.00. Engraving of trophies is the responsibility of the holder. **Please clean trophies before return.** **Welfare of Dogs** A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS** Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
