Trial Entries: Retriever trials - FTMS preferred. Spaniel trials - Paper entries Preference is that you type your entry, print and post to the Spaniel Sec. **Draws** will be published on the club website and returned via SAE if provided.

Start Time – All Trials meet at **9.00am** hrs for a **9.30am** prompt start – where reserves will be put in.

Covid 19 – Each individual entering has the primary responsibility for his or her own health and wellbeing and any risk factors relating to age or health, or health of close contacts, should be considered before entering an event.

All Trials – Will be held in accordance with the current Rules and Regulations of the Kennel Club. Reserves will be approached in a strict order. If a reserve cannot be contacted despite all possible efforts, the next reserve will be offered the run. This decision will stand even if the original reserve appears at the trial. Entry Fees may only be retained under Rule J6.F (1)- (5). Should any stake be abandoned, after all expenses are paid the remaining monies will be divided between the nominees. Those applicants that do not get a run will have their cheques destroyed. The Club reserves the right to refuse entries. Persons who have been refused membership may not enter this society's Trials. Should circumstances so dictate the society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements, as necessary. **Late Entry** – If your entry arrives after the closing date it may be put at the end of the draw. No substitution of dogs while reserves stand for Retriever or Spaniel trials. **Withdrawals** – Reg J6 applies. After an applicant has been successful in a draw, or reserve accepted an offer of a run the applicant may be liable for the full entry fee if the place is not taken up by another competitor, unless a veterinary certificate is produced, Open stake winners where qualification to the championship has been gained, or Novice dogs have qualified out of novice or gained an open stake award after the draw, or in the case of local lock down or Covid isolation. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B. All dog's resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the competitor. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements, as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership. Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host. **Open-** A Stake in which dogs have the opportunity of gaining a qualification towards the title of Field Trial Champion (K Regulations refer) and towards entry in the Championship or Champion Stake for its breed; in which entry is open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds except that such Stakes may not be confined to Any Variety Spaniel [except Spaniel (Cocker) and Spaniel (English Springer)]. It may be limited to a prescribed number of runners, in which case these shall be decided by a draw conducted in accordance with Regulation J7.i. so that preference is given to previous performance. **Novice** Retrievers/Spaniels: A Stake which is confined to dogs which have not gained a place which would qualify them for first preference in the draw for Open Stakes. **Prizes** – Certificates & Appropriate trophies. Prize money for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings. **Trophies** must be returned 1 month before the trial – Failure to return a Trophy by this date will result in a fine of £50.00. Engraving of trophies is the responsibility of the holder. **Please clean trophies before return.** **Welfare of Dogs** An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any field trial licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue or within the precincts of the trial. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS** Your dog is vulnerable and **AT RISK** if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.
